- Establish your chapter's eligibility requirements and draft your bylaws. NTHS requires an overall, unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher, and enrollment in a career/technical program or major. You may include other desired criteria such as CTSO membership, attendance, community service project participation, etc.
- Click <u>Forms, Brochures & Info</u> to view sample invitations and print applications and occupational codes.
- Customize the <u>PowerPoint presentation</u> to show at your informational meeting.
- Invite eligible students to join NTHS and hold a brief informational meeting.
- Distribute NTHS brochures and membership applications; show your PowerPoint.
- Introduce the <u>Jon H. Poteat Scholarship</u>, which is open from September 1 April 20 annually (click <u>Scholarships</u> under Member tab on home page). Announce CTSO scholarships listed on our site. NTHS members who have *not graduated* may apply.
- Students must fill out applications completely; valid email addresses are required.
- Set a deadline for applications and payments to be returned.
