



Defails

AWARD: 250 one-thousand dollar scholarships awarded on behalf of NTHS.

ELIGIBILITY: Reserved exclusively for active high school members of all grades as well as post-secondary NTHS members. Students are considered active members from the date they join until 6 months after their graduation date.

APPLICATION: Housed and managed by NTHS. Application accessible to eligible members who must agree to terms & conditions before submission.

RECIPIENT SELECTION: NTHS uses a random choice generator to select 250 potential recipients. Those names are submitted to the NTHS Advisors for approval. Replacements are randomly pulled for any member denied Advisor approval. This process continues until 250 official recipients are approved.

NOTIFICATION & ANNOUNCEMENT: All JHP recipients will be notified by email and receive official scholarship package by mail. Recipient names will be posted on website and/or be featured on all NTHS social media platforms. Press release is available upon request.



NTHS/BYF SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2018, the National Technical Honor Society (NTHS)/Build Your Future (BYF) Scholarship program is classified as a merit based academic scholarship created to provide additional scholarship opportunities to eligible applicants who hold NTHS membership and are committed to pursuing careers in construction-related disciplines. In collaboration with National Center for Construction Education & Research, Ltd. and its BYF initiative, this award program is designed and managed by NTHS.

AWARD: Five (5) two-thousand dollar scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY: Active NTHS members registered with a construction-related occupational code.

APPLICATION: Merit-based application housed and managed by NTHS. Application is accessible to eligible members who will submit NTHS member information, three essays, list of achievements and letter of recommendation. Applicants must agree to scholarship terms and conditions.

RECIPIENT SELECTION: Recipients will be selected by an NTHS appointed scholarship committee who will evaluate and rank each application based on the purpose and goals of the NTHS/BYF Scholarship. Upon BYF approval, the five (5) applicants with the highest combined score will become official recipients.

NOTIFICATION & ANNOUNCEMENT: Recipients will receive notification from the NTHS Scholarship Program Director by email. Recipient names will be posted on both NTHS and NCCER and/or BYF website and featured on all NTHS and NCCER/BYF social media platforms. Press release is available upon request.

AWARD: Three (3) one-thousand dollar scholarships.



AWARD: One (1) five-hundred dollar scholarship.


ELIGIBILITY: Candidates must be current NTHS members registered with the LAPSEN endorsement.

Please Note:

- All NTHS Scholarship recipients receive an official scholarship package mailed from the NTHS Headquarters. Packages include congratulatory letter & certificate, medallion, scholarship recipient decal and scholarship acceptance instructions.
- 2 All NTHS Scholarship recipients are expected to adhere to NTHS Scholarship Program policies. Recipients formally accept the scholarship offer by submitting a signed Affidavit & Agreement to the NTHS Scholarship Program Director by a predetermined deadline. Failure to submit these time-sensitive forms by the deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 3 All NTHS Scholarship funds are non-renewable. A one-time payment will be made towards tuition to the recipient's school of choice. NTHS reserves the right of discretion to determine accreditation credentials of usage requests. Funds will not be paid, nor refunded directly to a recipient.
- 4 Scholarship funds are held in trust for three (3) years for recipients of the JHP, BPA, DECA, FBLA-PBL, FCCLA, HOSA, LAPSEN and SkillsUSA Scholarships. Funds are held in trust for one (1) year for recipients of the BYF(NCCER), C. Allen Powell Alumni and NTHS/GEICO Alumni Scholarships.
